**ADMISSION:** \$5.00 (6 years & under free) per day. Skate Canada members will be admitted free by showing current membership card.

## GENERAL INFORMATION FOR SYNCHRO & ADULT

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES OF THE COMPETITION (January 30, 2026) except in the case of one entry in an event. In this case, the team/skater will be notified and may withdraw with a full refund or skate for an evaluation. When skating for an evaluation no medals will be awarded. Each team will receive a report card for their skate and \$10.00 per skater will be refunded. Skating for evaluation in adult events is only applicable to free skating and artistic categories.

Skaters entering multiple disciplines or double teamers should be aware that there may be scheduling conflicts resulting in less-than-ideal scheduling, or that are unable to be resolved.

**AGE:** The age for all competitors in all events shall be the age before July 1, 2025. **For Synchro**, copies of birth certificates for all team members must be with the team manager during the competition in case of an age challenge.

**ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** Skaters/teams must check-in at the competition registration desk at least one hour before they are scheduled to warm-up. Keep in mind that events may start up to 30 minutes earlier than scheduled if the competition is running ahead of schedule.

**WARM UP TIMES – Synchro:** Warm-up periods will be allotted to all teams as follows: Each team shall be allowed one (1) minute of warm-up (without music) on the competition ice surface immediately prior to their performance. Warm-up time will begin from the moment the team is announced.

### WARM UP TIMES – Adult

At the discretion of the Referee, the warm up periods may be reduced to a minimum of 3 minutes. All warm-up periods for one event must be equal.

**PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS:** For all synchro and adult events planned program sheets must be submitted online on through Wufoo by **February 11, 2026**. There will be a \$30 fee assessed for failing to register planned program elements online by the December 11, 2026 deadline. Skaters/Teams will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and a planned program sheet has been completed. ## **MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:**

- All teams and skaters must submit music online as part of the registration process.
- Music will only be accepted electronically via MP3 format. Do not begin the registration process until you have your music file ready to load. Questions can be directed to Haley Adams at [bcytsection@skatinginbc.com](mailto:bcytsection@skatinginbc.com)
- Music files are not kept for the next competition. Teams and Skaters must submit their music for each individual competition.
- Teams and competitors must hand in their back up file – either USB flash drive - at the registration desk at least one hour prior to when they are scheduled to skate. The Organizing Committee will accept no responsibility against damage but will take every precaution to safeguard each USB.
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.
- The backup format is a USB flash drive.

**SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:** A tentative schedule of events will be posted on the [competition page](#) of the BC/YT Section website. Any last-minute changes to schedules will be posted on the website and at the arena. **Please note that events may start up to one half hour earlier than scheduled.**

**COACHES:** In order to be at ice level during the events, it is mandatory for all participating coaches to register at the competition and show proof of their 2025/26 Coach Card. Temporary accreditation will be issued for a fee of \$25.00, for failure to show your Coach Card, and by proving a current “In Good Standing” status on [www.skatecanada.ca](http://www.skatecanada.ca).

**ADMISSION:** \$5.00 (6 years & under free) per day. Skate Canada members will be admitted free by showing a current membership card.

**MEDALS:** Will be awarded in all events with more than one entry in the competition.

**MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:** Synchro medal presentations will take place on the ice at the conclusion of the final synchro event. Skaters must be in skates and costumes for medal presentations. Any Team support staff (coaches, managers, alternates etc) must be in skates to go on the ice for medal presentations. Anyone in shoes will not be allowed on the ice.

Adult medal presentations will take place off the ice in the lobby at the conclusion of all the events.

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that use of flash cameras is forbidden. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials. **PLEASE NOTE:** You may only take pictures or videos of your own skater/team.

**PROTESTS:** [Skate Canada Protest rule](#) for competitions using CPC will be followed. In addition, if there is an event using manual calculation where the results are not posted within one hour of the completion of the last event of the day, the protest must be made to the Event Referee within the first hour of the following day’s competition. If the Event Referee is unavailable, the protest may be made

to the Technical Representative.

STAR 4 Synchro skaters must have all passed the STAR 1 Skill Assessment by the closing date of entry. There are no other test assessments.

All teams will skate twice except for STAR 3 & 4 who will skate once. STAR 3 teams will receive an assessment of Gold/Silver/ Bronze as in STAR 3.

STAR 4 teams will be assessed and ranked as in STAR 4.

Birth certificates are not required when registering on-line. However, the Team Manager should always carry a copy of all team members' birth certificates with them in case of an age challenge.
